LSLCA DOCK RENTAL FEES **ARE DUE APRIL 1ST**

The 2026 Registration fee for the boat to be docked at your LSLCA Rental Slip must be paid before or when you pay your 2025 Dock Rental Fee (*per your dock agreement*).

If you have not paid your LSLCA dock rental fee by **April 1st**, you have **forfeited your right to that slip and the slip will be offered to the next person on the waiting list.**

There are no exceptions.

(see Lakes & Parks Rules & Regulations, page 9, section 16).

Water Patrol NOTICE:

Prior to obtaining Class/Category 8 boat registration stickers, ALL Class 8 owners (new and returning) must contact Water Patrol for the Annual Class-8 Inspections per L&P MASTER RULES & REGULATIONS, section IV. BOATING RULES, #24 (page 12).

“...Amendment: The LSLCA understands that some of the new style boats now have ballast/bags and wedges that are non-removable/ingrained into the boat. The water patrol will inspect all Class 8 boats annually and have the owner sign an agreement that they will not use these devices on LSLCA lakes...”
per L&P MASTER RULES & REGULATIONS, section IV. BOATING RULES, #18.

*Anyone who has not paid for their LSLCA slip rental fee and boat by **8am on April 1st** will forfeit their right to that slip and it will be given to the next person on the waiting list.*

There are no exceptions or appeals of this rule.”

**ALL BOATS ENTERING DAUPHINE COVE ARE TO STAY
IN THE NO WAKE ZONE DUE TO ONGOING DREDGING**

Boat Registration & Rental Dock Reminders:

ONLINE BOAT REGISTRATION PAYMENT -

WHEN YOU PICK UP YOUR STICKERS:

You must provide the following:

- **Original Boat Title & Motor Title** (outboard only) to prove ownership (**NO COPIES**)
- Proof of insurance for Boat and Motor (outboard only)

NOTE: You MUST have all paperwork to receive your boat stickers.

**** Please allow 2 business days after you submit your online payment.****

If you are out of town or unable to put your stickers on your boat please contact Water Patrol @ 636-625-3120 to make arrangements and avoid a fine.

- ♦ **NOTE:** The boat assigned to the slip must be properly registered first. We **MUST** see the original title(s) of the registered boat prior to accepting the dock payment.
- ♦ **Boats on/above/near the water** **MUST** have the LSLCA 2026 registration stickers displayed by APRIL 1st. Failure to display current year's stickers results in a \$100 fine. Failure to display by May 1st (and subsequent months) will result in a 30-day suspension each time.

DREDGING REPORT UPDATE:

Muck Miners has all of the dredge pipe needed to come up the creek welded together at our Duello Site and is getting ready to run the pipe down the creek to the lake. The dredge and booster pump have been delivered to Donnie's point along with the pipe that will be needed to go from the booster pump to the dredge.

PROCEDURES FOR CA BOAT LIFTS

Rental docks Only—Slips with an approved lift must pay \$825 Lift Deposit and fill out a Lift Agreement form at the Front Desk of the CA Office.

Please do **NOT** purchase a boat lift until the lift measurements can be verified to see if the lift will adequately fit inside your half of the rental slip!

All boat lifts must be installed inside their half (50%) of the rental slip with adequate space allowed between the 2 boat lifts. Most lifts cannot be over 10' wide for rental slips (measured from outside foot to outside foot).

ALL New & Used boat lifts require a 5-step approval process

Before a boat lift can be installed. This includes boat lifts being installed in personal docks...and CA rental docks. It is the owner's responsibility to submit the paperwork to get approval. If a boat lift is installed *without* a permit, the CA can demand that it be removed permanently at the owner's expense. The 5-Step Lakefront Project Approval form must be completed along with the regular application for all Lakefront projects (Including docks, lifts & seawalls).

BOATING SAFETY COURSES

These courses are done in person. This is a one time course; if you have taken our class there is no need to take it again.

All Boats & Boat Trailers are to be stored away from your homes or put inside of your garage. Parking them on the driveway or on the side of your house is not allowed.

On Saturday, April 11, join Greenway Network, St. Charles County and the communities of Cottleville, Dardenne Prairie, Lake Saint Louis, O'Fallon, St. Charles, St. Peters, and Wentzville help to remove trash from local streams and lakes.

Mission: Clean Stream has evolved into a challenge for many to do some serious damage to the amount of trash in our waterways in a very short amount of time. In 2024, roughly 1,000 volunteers pulled 11 tons of trash out of Dardenne, Perdue, Belleau, Spencer and Cole Creeks in about two hours.

And even better, *Mission: Clean Stream* has gotten creative with the objects volunteers find in creeks. Local artists will be on site creating new works of eco-art from salvaged metal for the Stream Trash ART (START) project.





Registration cost is \$165 per swimmer for CA members, \$265 for Non-CA members. Discounts are available for 3 or more swimmers from a family.

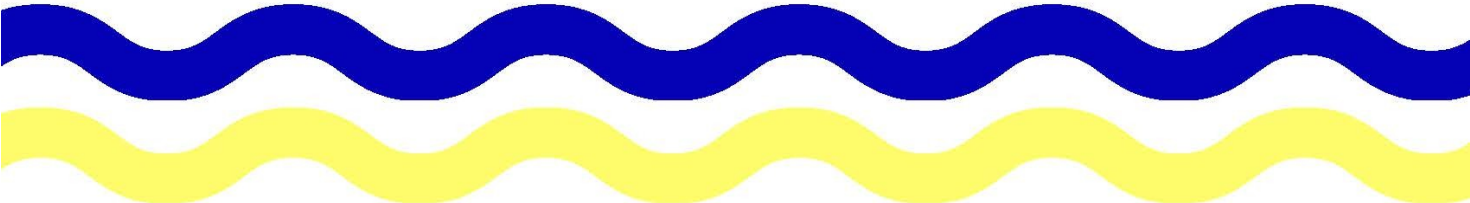
Families are required to volunteer for 1/2 a meet at 4 meets. A deposit of \$300 per family is required and is held in escrow to ensure all volunteer duties are completed.
