



REQUIRED LSLCA BOATING SAFETY COURSE



CURRENT RESIDENTS **MUST** TAKE A BOATING SAFETY COURSE BEFORE A YOUR WATERCRAFT CAN BE APPROVED FOR USE ON BOTH LAKES.

CLASS 2, 3, AND 4 BOAT OWNERS ARE NOW REQUIRED TO ATTEND THE BOATING SAFETY CLASS BEFORE REGISTERING THEIR BOAT FOR THE 2020 BOATING SEASON.

THIS IS A 1 TIME REQUIREMENT. ONCE YOU HAVE COMPLETED THE BOATING SAFETY CLASS, YOU MAY REGISTER ANY CLASS BOAT THAT IS IN YOUR NAME WITHOUT HAVING TO ATTEND THE CLASS AGAIN.

NEW RESIDENTS THAT ARE CONSIDERING PUTTING A WATERCRAFT ON EITHER LAKE **MUST** TAKE THE LSLCA BOATING SAFETY CLASS, HAVE A WATER PATROL INSPECTION AND THE BOAT MUST MEET THE L&P REQUIREMENTS ON SIZE AND WEIGHT BEFORE HAVING THEIR WATERCRAFT REGISTERED FOR USE ON OUR LAKES.
