Snow Removal Procedures

The City of Lake Saint Louis Public Works Department is responsible for snow removal on approximately 180 lane miles of roadway and will deploy vehicles to eight routes removing snow on two 12-hours shifts throughout a winter storm in order to provide 24 hour winter coverage. Crews are also in contact with police dispatchers and a roving supervisor/mechanic with plow truck can direct them to additional areas needing treatment, or assist directly in a winter storm.
