Boat Registration & Dock Slip Rental Reminders

When registering your boat in person remember to bring with you:

Payment in person;

- 1. Your original boat title *
- 2. The original Outboard motor title *

Proof of insurance

* The name on the title must be of the homeowner(s). Persons outside of the CA may be named as TOD

Upon receipt of payment, the front desk will issue your 2022 boat, trailer and (if needed) auto stickers

For online payments.

Once paid online your 2022 boat stickers will be sent to the Water Patrol office.

When you are ready to pick them up please have with you

- 1. Your original boat title*
- 2. The original Outboard motor title*
- 3. Proof of insurance
- The name on the title must be of the homeowner(s). Persons outside of the CA may be named as TOD

Those residents whose boats are on / over the water, traveling and not planning to be back prior to April 1.

1. Should pay for your watercraft online

Call (636) 625.3120 or email Steve the water patrol office (<u>sbernstein@lslca.com</u>). He will make arrangements to see that you will not be fined for late stickers. He will need the date you plan to be back in town to pick up your stickers.

If you need help putting your stickers on your boat or are physically unable to do so, please bring your stickers into the Water Patrol office and we will schedule a time to put your stickers on the boat. This is for boats on or over the water only (not boats in storage or trailered).

If any resident whose boat is on or over the water cannot meet the April 1 deadline, please contact Steve at Water Patrol to see if arrangements can be made.
