ACC GUIDELINES:

PROCEDURES FOR BOAT LIFTS BEING INSTALLED IN CA RENTAL SLIPS

Please do <u>NOT</u> purchase a boat lift until the rental slip can be measured to see if the lift will adequately fit inside your half of the slip!

All boat lifts must be installed inside their half (50%) of the rental slip with adequate space allowed between the 2 boat lifts.

Since all rental slips are not the same width, it may not be possible to have 2 boat lifts installed in the same rental slip.

<u>ALL New & Used boatlifts require a 5-step approval process</u> before they can be installed. This includes boatlifts being installed in personal docks...and CA rental docks.

It is the owner's responsibility to submit the paperwork to get approval. If a boat lift is installed *without* a permit, the CA can demand that it be removed permanently at the owner's expense.

The 5-Step Lakefront Project Approval form must be completed along with the regular application for all Lakefront projects (Including docks, lifts & seawalls).

** Reminder: Even though you may get LSL City approval on an outdoor project, ACC approval is needed as well on ALL Outside Projects.**

Rental docks Only—Slips with an approved lift must pay \$825 Lift Deposit and fill out a Lift Agreement form at the Front Desk of the CA Office.

LSLCA DOCK RENTAL FEES ARE DUE APRIL 1ST

If you have not paid your LSLCA dock rental fee by April 1st, you have forfeited your right to that slip and the slip will be offered to the next person on the waiting list. There are no exceptions.

If you are out of town, you can pay your dock rental fee online or contact the office to make your payment prior to April 1st.

• The 2023 registration fee for the boat to be docked at your LSLCA Rental Slip must be paid before or when you pay your 2023 Dock Rental Fee (per your dock agreement).

Please make sure the CA Office has your current phone # and email address in the event we need to contact you regarding any issues, your boats or water toys loose and found on the lakes, upcoming events and changes you need to be aware of.

Boat Registration & Rental Dock Reminders:

All boat owners must have completed the LSLCA Boating Safety Class before they can register any class boat with a motor for the 2023 boating season.

- To register your boat for 2023 at the CA office, you must provide the following:
- Original Boat Title & Motor Title (outboard only) to prove ownership (NO COPIES)
- Proof of insurance for Boat and Motor (outboard only)

Newly obtained boats, Class 7 & 8 boats, Up-Graded Motors

must have the completed and approved Water Patrol Inspection Form

NOTE: You MUST have all paperwork to receive your boat stickers

ONLINE BOAT REGISTRATION PAYMENT

Your will pick up you 2023 REGISTRATION STICKERS @ the Water Patrol Office (located at the Main Marina)

You must provide the following:

- Original Boat & Motor (outboard only) title(s) (NO COPIES)
- Proof of current Insurance coverage

Upon verification, the Water Patrol staff will hand you your boat stickers. Please call Water Patrol @ 636-625-3120, prior to stopping by to verify hours of operation (hours vary by season)

**NOTE: Please allow 2 business days after you submit your online payment.

Boats that are on or above the water MUST have the current year's registration stickers displayed **by April 1**ST. Failure to display current year's stickers will result in a \$100 fine. Failure to display by May 1st (and subsequent months) will result in a 30-day suspension each time.

If you are out of town or unable to put your stickers on your boat please contact Water Patrol @ 636-625-3120 to make arrangements and avoid a fine.

• **NEW BOAT INSPECTIONS**—Are no longer virtual. Please call and set up a date and time to have Water Patrol inspect your boat and safety equipment.

Announcement: Lake Forest Lease Amendment is Complete

In October 2022, the LSLCA Board of Directors and the Lake Forest Board of Directors negotiated a lease amendment to our current lease agreement with Lake Forest that was set to expire in 13 years. In conjunction with the LSLCA Finance Committee, the LSLCA Board of Directors conducted research on current lease provisions for similar arrangements and reviewed the financial impact an amendment would have for the LSLCA membership.

Under the previous lease, Lake Forest Country Club was able to lease 93 acres of LSLCA common ground for their 18-hole golf course for \$1.00 per year. The lease amendment alters the lease payment to \$1500.00 monthly for year 1 (2023), \$2000.00 monthly for year 2 (2024), \$2500.00 monthly for year 3 (2025), and a 3% increase annually for every year thereafter during the new 30-year term (expiring in 2053). The new lease includes the benefits to the LSLCA membership that were available under the previous Lake Forest lease, including discounted pricing (contact Lake Forest for details), while also creating a more favorable return on investment for the membership as a whole.
