****CA REMINDERS ****

- **ACC APPROVAL**— Architectural control committee is looking for new members. If you are interested please fill out a form in office or contact Shirley at 636-625-8276 ext:109
- If you are changing anything on the exterior of you house, you need to make sure you get it approved by the Architectural Control Committee. (Examples: Paint colors on doors and garages, roof, siding, decks, patios, retaining walls, seawalls, docks and boat lifts).
- All contractors doing work on the lake such as sea walls, dock and lifts need to check in with water patrol and show permit given by ACC.

BOATING SAFETY COURSE-

In order to register your class 5, 6, 7, or 8 boat in 2019, you MUST take the Boating Safety Course offered by LSLCA Water Patrol.

REMINDER: All class 5-8 Boat owners MUST have taken the Boating Safety Course before they can register their Class 5-8 Boat for the 2019 Boating Season.

All class 2-4 Boat owners MUST complete the class before they can register for the 2020 Boating Season.

ALL Class 8 boats MUST be re-inspected by Water Patrol and fee paid to the Anglers prior to registering their boat for the 2019 Boating Season.

If you still need to take the class, contact Water Patrol @ 636-625-3120 to register for a class. We offer the class every month and it takes 1 hour.

REMINDER 2019 ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS— If you would like to pay online, go to LSLCA.COM and login. Your MEMBER NUMBER to log in is your CUSTOMER NO: located in the upper right corner of your statement. If you have not logged in previously, your password will also be your CUSTOMER NO: (login & password must be all CAPS). Please put your Customer # (located in the upper right corner of your statement) on your check when you pay your Assessment.

2018 C.A. CARDS ARE YOUR FOREVER CARDS You do not have to come in and get a new one every year. Once you have paid your 2019 assessments your card will be reactivated. If your card is lost, there is a \$10 fee to replace it.
