Description of her job: Processes Annual Assessment payments through mail or walk-ins as well as totaling on-line payments. Takes payments & completes paperwork for boat registration & amenity fees (walk-in and online), runs reports and completes daily deposits for the office, bar & restaurant, golf, Cabana, Windjammer and golf shack, takes calls for the maintenance log, updates ID cards. Also, takes care of trustee letters from title companies, liens, lien releases, answers phones (which can at times be very lengthy depending on how many questions the caller has). Maintains and makes calls from the dock move list and wait list to members who are requesting to rent a dock slip from the CA, this is a very detailed process... and many more tasks that occur at different times throughout the year.

They come in to pay assessments, register their boats or pay for amenities and we get to share stories.
