ACC GUIDELINES:

Attention Property Owners—Please be reminded that all "Lakefront project applications must be submitted 10 days prior to the ACC meeting date. All other applications must be submitted by 5:00pm on Monday, the week of the ACC meeting.

The ACC only meets twice a month on the second and fourth Thursday.

ALL new & used boat lifts must be submitted for prior approval *before* they can be installed in a CA rental dock or in a personal dock.

Boat lifts are not allowed at the Main Marina or in rental slips where the water may be too deep. You must check with the Water Patrol or ACC Coordinator *before* you purchase a new or used boat lift. Do not assume they have been previously submitted for approval by a Dealer or contractor.

It is the owner's responsibility to submit the paperwork to get approval. If a boat lift is installed *without* a permit, the CA can demand that it be removed permanently at the owner's expense.

Rental docks Only—Must pay \$825 Lift Deposit and fill out a Lift Agreement form at the Front Desk of the CA Office.

BIG LAKE LOWERING FOR 2022: October 15- December 15th the Big Lake will be lowered by 3' for maintenance.

BOATING SAFETY COURSES: Please contact Water Patrol to schedule a date and time: 636-625-3120. This is a One time course—if you have taken our class there is no need to take it again. If your not sure please call.

BOAT REGISTRATION: Any Boat on the water or above the water (on a lift) must have 2022 Registration stickers displayed by April 1st. **Original Titles and Proof of Insurance are REQUIRED to register.** For your convenience you can pay your Boat registration online & pick-up stickers from the Water Patrol Office & Water Patrol will copy your title & Check Proof of Insurance when you pick up your stickers.
