Boat Registration & Rental Dock Reminders:

All **New** boat owners must have completed the LSLCA Boating Safety Class before they can register any class boat with a motor for the 2025 boating season.

· **To register your boat for 2025 at the CA office,**
you must provide the following:

- **Original Boat Title & Motor Title** (outboard only) to prove ownership
(NO COPIES)
- Proof of insurance for Boat and Motor (outboard only)

NOTE: You MUST have all paperwork to receive your boat stickers

ONLINE BOAT REGISTRATION PAYMENT -

WHEN YOU PICK UP YOUR STICKERS: You must provide the following:

- **Original Boat Title & Motor Title** (outboard only) to prove ownership
(NO COPIES)
- Proof of insurance for Boat and Motor (outboard only)

NOTE: You MUST have all paperwork to receive your boat sticker

**** Please allow 2 business days after you submit your online payment.****

If you are out of town or unable to put your stickers on your boat please contact Water Patrol @ 636-625-3120 to make arrangements and avoid a fine.

PROCEDURES FOR CA BOAT LIFTS

Rental docks Only—Slips with an approved lift must pay \$825 Lift Deposit and fill out a Lift Agreement form at the Front Desk of the CA Office.

Please do **NOT** purchase a boat lift until the lift measurements can be verified to see if the lift will adequately fit inside your half of the rental slip!

All boat lifts must be installed inside their half (50%) of the rental slip with adequate space allowed between the 2 boat lifts. Most lifts cannot be over 10' wide for rental slips (measured from outside foot to outside foot).

ALL New & Used boat lifts require a 5-step approval process

Before a boat lift can be installed. This includes boat lifts being installed in personal docks...and CA rental docks. It is the owner's responsibility to submit the paperwork to get approval. If a boat lift is installed *without* a permit, the CA can demand that it be removed permanently at the owner's expense. The 5-Step Lakefront Project Approval form must be completed along with the regular application for all Lakefront projects (Including docks, lifts & seawalls).

BOATING SAFETY COURSES

These courses are done in person. This is a one time course;
if you have taken our class there is no need to take it again.

****REMINDER****

All Boats & Boat Trailers are to be stored away from your homes
or put inside of your garage. Parking them on the driveway
or on the side of your house is not allowed.

**The CA's swimming and wading pools
are located behind the Clubhouse.**

**CA members can purchase an annual Amenity Pass
or pay the daily fee for entry — Members \$7, Guests \$8.**

**Daily pool passes can be purchased at the Cabana,
or the Golf Shack (after 5pm).**

**The following rules must be followed by
all CA members and guests:**

- Only CA members and guests are allowed in the pool area.
- To gain access to the pool or beach areas, CA members MUST have a valid CA ID card in their possession.
- Children under 15 years old must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Persons with acute or obvious skin or body infections, cuts, open sores, colds, or discharge are not allowed to enter the pool water.
- No glass allowed within the pool enclosure or at the beach.
- No animals allowed except for service animals.
- NO food, drinks, gum, tobacco or **alcohol** of any kind shall be permitted in or near the pool water.
- Keep gate(s) closed - do not prop open.
- Showers are required before entering the pool. Skin and hair must be clear of sand and other debris from the lake before entering pool water.
- If incontinent, wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants or a swim diaper.
- Observe all safety regulations.
- Everyone MUST rinse off before entering the pool, especially if they're coming from the lake. If they don't the phosphates will turn the pool green and we will have to shut down the pool until the chemicals are balance again.

JUNE GARDEN OF THE MONTH being honored by Jardin du Lac - #5 Edgewater Island

The June Garden of the Month honor has been awarded to Peter and Mary Jo Gallagher, whose home at # 5 Edgewater Island welcomes visitors to walk the stone path, through Mary Jo's vision of an "English cottage garden", in order to reach the front door.

Mary Jo has spent the ten years that they have lived at #5 Edgewater Island breaking ground using a variety of tools including pick axes, and serrated spades to create the garden of her imaginings. She created the stone walkway and opened up spaces to plant a variety of trees including ; Japanese maples, red maple, oriental arborvitae, and river birch. She has used the same tools and more to add hostas, big leaf and oak leaf hydrangeas, azaleas, Japanese spirea, peonies, ferns, daylilies, China rose, giant onions, balloon flowers, lilies of the valley and ground cover varieties of Vinca and creeping Jenny.

The garden bed to the right of the drive has an assortment of bee blossom, guara, primrose, stokes asters, salvia, peonies, Joe- pye weed, daisies, astillibe, purple loosestrife and irises that are in bloom all summer long. Large leafed hostas finish the bed and align with the side of the garage. The entire garden seems to beckon a person to enter and take a seat on one of white metal chairs in the shade and enjoy the colorful comfort.
