BOAT REGISTRATION: Any Boat on the water or above the water (on a lift) must have 2022 Registration stickers displayed by April 1st. **Original Titles and Proof of Insurance are REQUIRED to register.** For your convenience you can pay your Boat registration online & pick -up stickers from the Water Patrol Office & Water Patrol will copy your title & Check Proof of Insurance when you pick up your stickers.

Don't wait until the last minute if you still need to register your boat to have it on the Lake for the 4th of July.
