**2020 BOAT REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT\*\*** When you register/renew your boat(s) for the 2020 season, you MUST show proof of ownership by supplying the office with your original title (or current property tax receipt), and proof of current insurance coverage. If paying your registration online, please email your information to <a href="mailto:frontdesk@lslca.com">frontdesk@lslca.com</a>. Also, **ALL CLASS 8 BOATS** need an annual inspection by Water Patrol prior to your 2020 boat registration.

**Private Golf Carts** used on the Golf Course in 2020 will require an annual inspection by a Golf Shack employee and an annual registration fee of \$25.00 paid at the time of the inspection. At the time you pay the \$25.00 fee, a sticker will be given to you that you MUST display on your private Golf Cart confirming you have had your annual inspection and paid your annual Golf Cart fee.

You will only be allowed to use your private golf cart on the Golf Course if you have your annual Golf Cart sticker displayed.
