		 Motion: Recommend the CA Board of Directors approve the following changes to the Lakes & Parks Rules and Regulations: Section I Definitions, Item N: Sunset – The link on the LSLCA website providing the time when the sun disappears below the horizon. Section I Definitions, Item O: Sunrise – The link on the LSLCA website providing the time when the sun appears above the horizon. Section III, B General, 1: After sunset and before sunrise times as provided on the LSLCA website, all waterskiing and other sports involving towing are prohibited on both lakes. Section III, B General, 8: A 10 mph SPEED LIMIT is in affect from sunset to sunrise times as provided on the LSLCA website. Speeding at night is considered "RECKLESS and DANGEROUS". Motion: Recommend the CA Board of Directors approve the following changes to the Lakes & Parks Rules and Regulations: Section III, B General, 19: Change the last sentence to read: "Boats with wedges, water ballast tanks or any other device designed to increase wakes are prohibited from being used on LSLCA Lakes." Section III, B General, #24: Change to read "All persons born after January 1, 1984, who operate any vessel on either Lake St Louis or Lake St Louise, must have on board his/her boating safety identification card (or online course completion document) issued by the Missouri State Water Patrol or other Federally approved boating courses, i.e., US Coast Guard Auxiliary, or other approved state boating courses. Motion: Recommend the CA Board of Directors direct Water Patrol and staff to develop and deploy a focused Education and Information campaign regarding boat wakes and their impact on overall boating enjoyment as

well as wear and tear on shoreline, docks, lifts and marina property. The campaign should include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following:

-Develop descriptive information and graphics showing how boats can produce relatively small wakes when operating at idle speeds and at hull planing speeds. Descriptions of how 'plowing' at speeds just under planing speed can produce dramatically large wakes. -Develop a 'good neighbor' message to encourage boaters not to 'plow' the water unless it is needed for watersport activities.

-Develop and publish articles and special features in NewsTime, the CA Monthly Newsletter and the CA Website to spread the above messages. Include this information in the CA Boating Safety Course. -Water Patrol conduct 'Courtesy Stops' to discuss boat wakes when they observe boaters 'plowing' or causing large wakes not related to watersports. Water Patrol to document and report Courtesy Stop activity as part of their monthly report.
