Lakes & Parks Rules & Regulations

- Water-Skiing, Tubing, Wake-Boarding are not permitted after Sunset and before Sunrise. 1st Violation - \$50 // 2nd Violation - \$100 // 3rd Violations - \$250
- Operating a Watercraft in a ways that endangers life, limb or property. 1st Violation - \$250 (+ 30 day suspension) // 2nd Violation - 12 month suspension of boating privileges
- Exceeding the 10 M.P.H. Speed Limit at night Considered RECKLESS & DANGEROUS. 1st Violation - \$250 // 2nd Violations - \$500 (+ 12-month suspension of boating privileges)
- Violation of Registration or Non-Display of Stickers 1st Violation - \$50 // 2nd Violation - \$100 // 3rd Violation - \$250
- Violation of Non-Registration 1st Violation - Full year registration + \$50 // 2nd Violation - Registration fee + \$100 3rd Violation - Registration + \$250
- Loud Music Offense: 1st Violation \$100 // 2nd Violation \$250 (+ 6-month suspension)
- Improper Life Jackets, and Safety Gear: 1st Violation \$50 // 2nd Violation \$100 // 3rd Violation \$250
- Swimming from the beaches is permitted only between sunrise and sunset. Swimming, jumping or entering the water from public docks and bridges or around the islands is prohibited.
